Use of evidence-based treatment guidelines support initiation and maintenance of drug treatments. However, many receive medication that is no longer needed and deprescribing of well-intentioned medication may be relevant, for instance, due to unacceptable side effects, lack of effect or the like. Deprescribing may be difficult and until recently, no evidence-based deprescribing guidelines have been available.

Evidence-based deprescribing guidelines have now been developed in Canada and Australia as the first in the world.
